### Construction Water Permit Policy Effective June 1, 2020

#### General Information:

- This District currently owns and rents 3 hydrant meters
- If a hydrant meter is available for use, the District can issue a Construction Water Permit
- The District will provide the location that the hydrant can be used

- Customers are charged \$5 per day with a \$50 minimum, in addition the following rates determined by usage apply:

Gallons		Rate per 1,000 Gallons
0	100,000	\$8.87
100,001	200,000	\$11.31
Over 200,000		\$15.06

#### Permitting:

- If a hydrant meter is available, the Contractor must provide the District a deposit of \$2,800 and proof of General Liability insurance, with the District listed as a certificate holder, with a minimum of \$1,000,000 per occurrence
- Contractors must keep a copy of the completed Perry Park Water and Sanitation District Construction Water Permit in the vehicle that is being used to haul water
- The Contractor will be informed that if any issues with the water distribution system are detected, they will be notified via the phone number on their construction permit that they must refrain from use until further notice
- The Contractor's vehicle for hauling water must have a backflow prevention device that is available for inspection by the District
- The Contractor must use a hydrant wrench to open and close the hydrant
- The Contractor should open the hydrant valve slowly to minimize impact to the distribution system
- The Contractor can flow a maximum of 200 gallons per minute
- The Contractor cannot string hoses across a street

#### After the Hydrant Meter is Returned:

- After the hydrant meter is returned, the hydrant and hydrant meter are inspected by the District, if any damage has been done to the hydrant and/or hydrant meter, the hydrant and/or hydrant meter is either repaired or replaced, the Contractor is responsible for any associated charges
- The District Office will generate an invoice for the number of days that the hydrant meter was in use, as well as the gallons that were used
- The Contractor's deposit can be used for payment or returned to the Contractor if payment is made separately
